



Old regulation:

If you had chartered a yacht in Croatia and entered a marina, port or bay, you had to pay the fee including the tourist-tax (per person) at this particular marina.

New regulation since 2009:

You have to pay the tourist-tax directly to the charter-operator*) at the base, in advance to embarkation, and in cash.

It is in the amount of 7 HKN/person/day (approx. 1 EUR/person/day), at one-time basis, covering the whole period of stay in charter.

You will get a receipt for your payment. Showing this when paying marina-fees, of course the tourist-tax is omitted.

Example:

Crew constists of 10 persons and is on the move for one charter-week: 10 personen x 7 days = 490,- Kuna

Please keep your invoice/receipt carefully, to avoid beeing recharged in other marinas.

*) The charter operator has to transfer totally collected amount to the Croatian Tourist Board account monthly, it's not an income for him.
